Subject: Florida Hurricane Idalia Disaster Notification – Update #4

FEMA Declaration Date: August 31, 2023

On August 31, 2023, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) declared that federal disaster aid with individual assistance has been made available to counties in Florida to supplement recovery efforts in the areas affected by Hurricane Idalia from **August 27, 2023, and continuing.**

On September 1, 2023, with Amendment No. 1., FEMA granted individual assistance to six (6) additional counties.

On September 3, 2023, with Amendment No. 2., FEMA granted individual assistance to one (1) additional county.

On September 4, 2023, with Amendment No. 3., FEMA announced an Incident Period End Date of September 4, 2023.

On September 9, 2023, with Amendment No. 5., FEMA granted individual assistance to two (2) additional counties.
